1 - DOES GOD HAVE A GOVERNMENT?

Psalm. 103:19: "The Lord hath prepared His throne in the heavens; and His _____ ruleth over all."

Psalm 89:14: "_____ and judgment are the habitation of Thy throne: mercy and truth shall go before Thy face." *Romans 7:12-*"The law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good" (*also Romans 7:14*).

4 - WHAT CONSTITUTES THE FUNDAMENTAL LAW OF GOD'S GOVERNMENT?

1. The law of Ten Commandments (Exodus 20:3-17) is the unchanging, eternal, and moral law of God.

2. God's law is eternal in its nature.

Psalm 111:7-8: "The works of His hands are verity and judgment; all His _____ are sure. They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in truth and uprightness."

5 - ARE THE TEN COMMANDMENTS FOR ALL MEN IN ALL AGES?

1. The law was for man, from Adam to Moses.

1 *John 3:4:* "Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for - is the transgression of the law" (*Cain: Genesis 4:6-7*).

Genesis 26:5: "Because that Abraham obeyed My voice, and kept My charge, My commandments. My statutes, and My laws."

2. It was for men, from Moses to Christ.

Proverbs 28:9: "He that _____ away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer shall be abomination" (also *Deuteronomy 5:22; 10:4-5*).

3. It was for Jesus, as the Son of man, and for men of His generation.

Psalm 40:7-8: "Lo. I come: in the volume of the book it is written _____ of Me. I _____ to do Thy Will. O my God: yea. Thy law is within my heart" (*Hebrews 10:7*).

4. It was for men in the time of the apostles.

Romans 8:81: "Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea. we establish the law."

James 2:10-12: "For whosoever shall _____ the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all. For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law. So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty."

1 John 2:4: "He that saith, I know Him, and keepeth not His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him."

5. It is for God's remnant people of the last days.

Revelation 12:17: "And the dragon was wroth With the woman, _____ and went to make war with the _____ of her seed, which keep the commandments of God. and have the testimony of Jesus Christ."

Revelation 14:12: "Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that _____ the commandments of God. And the faith of Jesus" (*verses 13-15*).

6 - WHY IS THERE GENERAL REBELLION AGAINST GOD'S HOLY LAW?

Romans 8:7: "The carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God. neither indeed can be."

Psalm 119:126: "It is _____ for thee, Lord, to work: for they have made void Thy law."

Matthew 7:21-28: "Not every one that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the _____ of My Father which is in heaven. Many will say to Me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Thy name? and in Thy name have cast out devils? and in Thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them. I never knew you: _____ from Me. ye that work iniquity."

7 - WHAT PROMISE IS HELD OUT TO THOSE WHO ARE OBEDIENT?

Psalm 119:165: "Great peace have they which love Thy law: and nothing shall offend them" (also *Isaiah 48:18*).
